GENERAL MEDICAL CONSENT DOCUMENT

In order for a General Medical Consent Document to be generated, it is necessary that the court check the appropriate line on the Suitable Placement Minute Order. The minute order must have the line checked that indicates, "The Probation Officer is authorized to provide medical, surgical, dental or other remedial care." If this line is not checked on the minute order, medical consent needs to be secured from the minor's parents(s) or legal guardian(s). If the minor's parent(s) or legal guardian(s) are not available, the DPO of Record will need to return the matter to court for the appropriate modification of the minute order.
